This document is part of the data analysis from Consultation Survey 1.
The associated document "Consultation Survey 1 Data Analysis - Other Opinions" records the open answers provided.

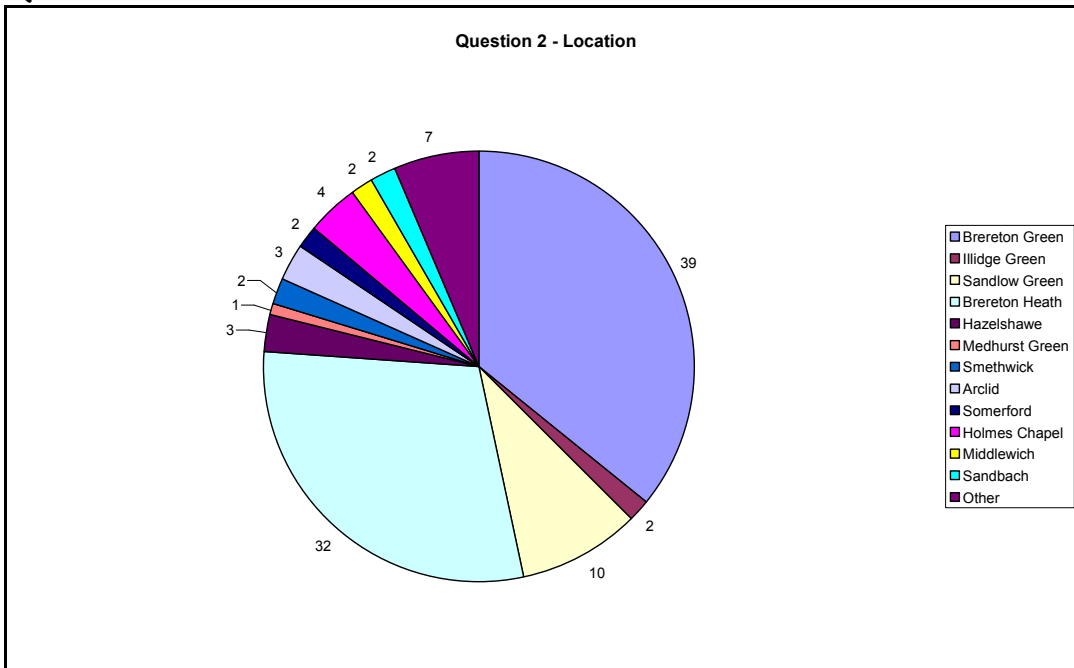
It includes the survey analysis of the following data:

- Responses to the General Survey Questionnaire received at the Consultation Event at Brereton Primary School on Saturday 16th March, and its immediate follow-up (TOTAL of 92 responses);
- Responses to the Business Survey Questionnaire delivered to all businesses identified in Brereton (Total of 5 responses)
- Responses to the General Survey Questionnaire received at the Consultation Event at Brereton Heath Local Nature Reserve on Sunday 21st April (TOTAL of 8 responses);
- Responses to the General Survey Questionnaire received from the Primary School and Playgroup (TOTAL of 1 response);
- Responses to the Young People Survey Game received from the Youth Forum on 2nd May (TOTAL of 10 responses).

All responses up to and including 17th May have been included.

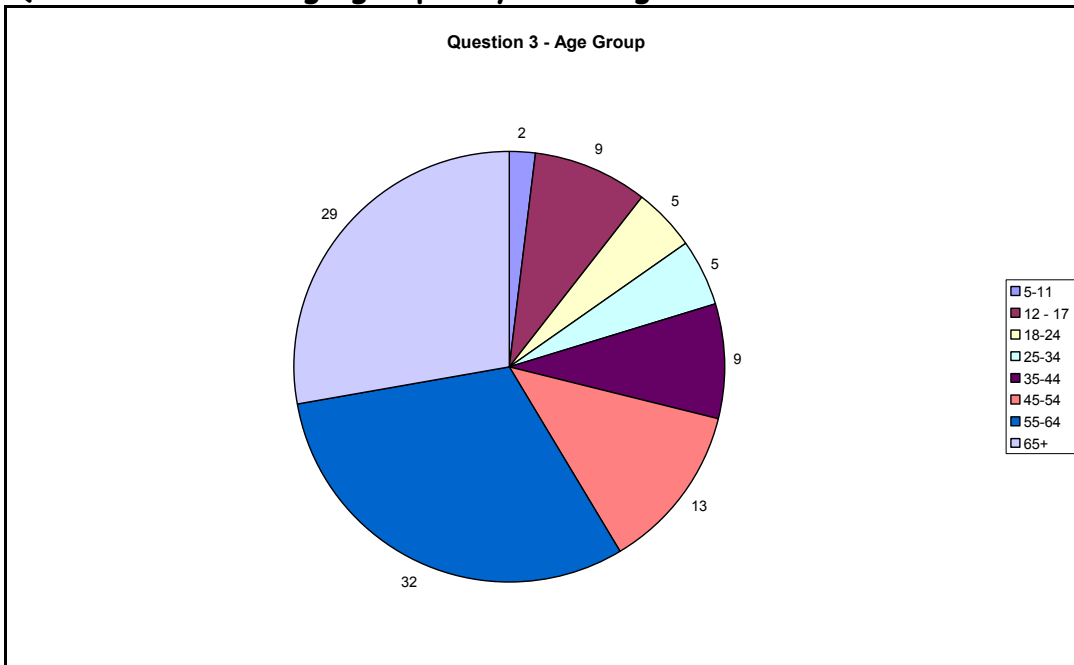
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Question 2: Location



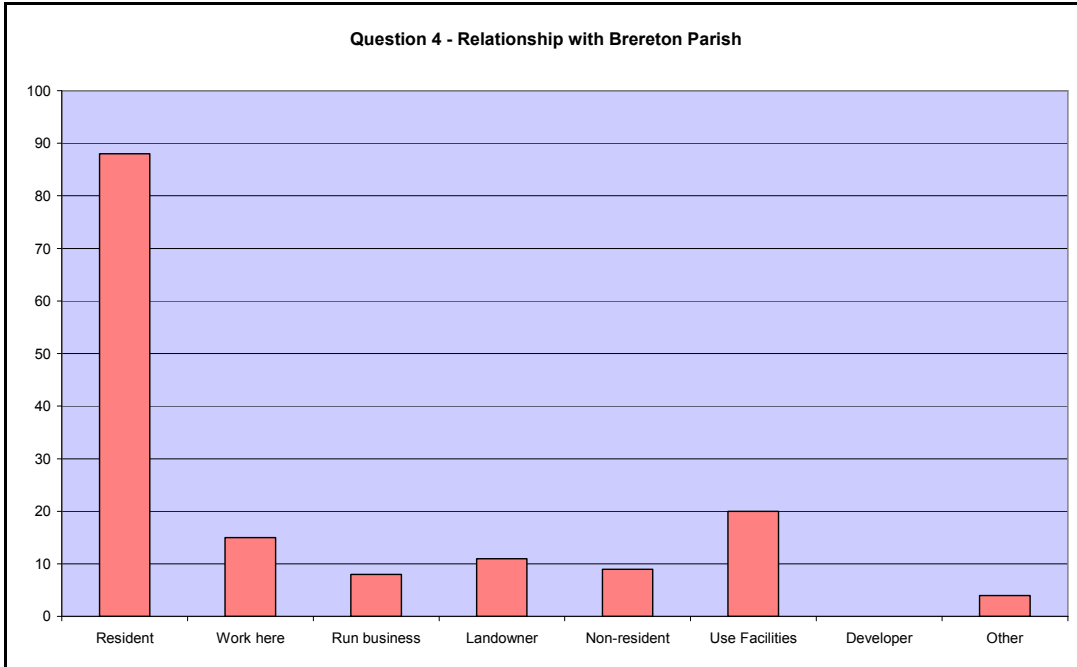
The majority of the respondents live in Brereton Green or Brereton Heath

Question 3: What age group do you belong to?



There is a higher proportion of people in the older age groups. 71% are over 45.

Question 4: Which of these describes your relationship with Brereton Parish?



Most people in the survey were residents.

Question 5: Please indicate for each of the following what you think about Brereton Parish?

This table records the average - what most people said.

The average responses were the same for residents and non-residents in the survey. They were also the same for different age groups apart from one category and age group: the responses in the 'It has good facilities' category for the 35-54 age group were split with 11 respondents disagreeing and 12 agreeing.

There were 5 people who strongly disagreed that there was any need for new homes to be built but thought that 1 - 50 was an appropriate number to build.

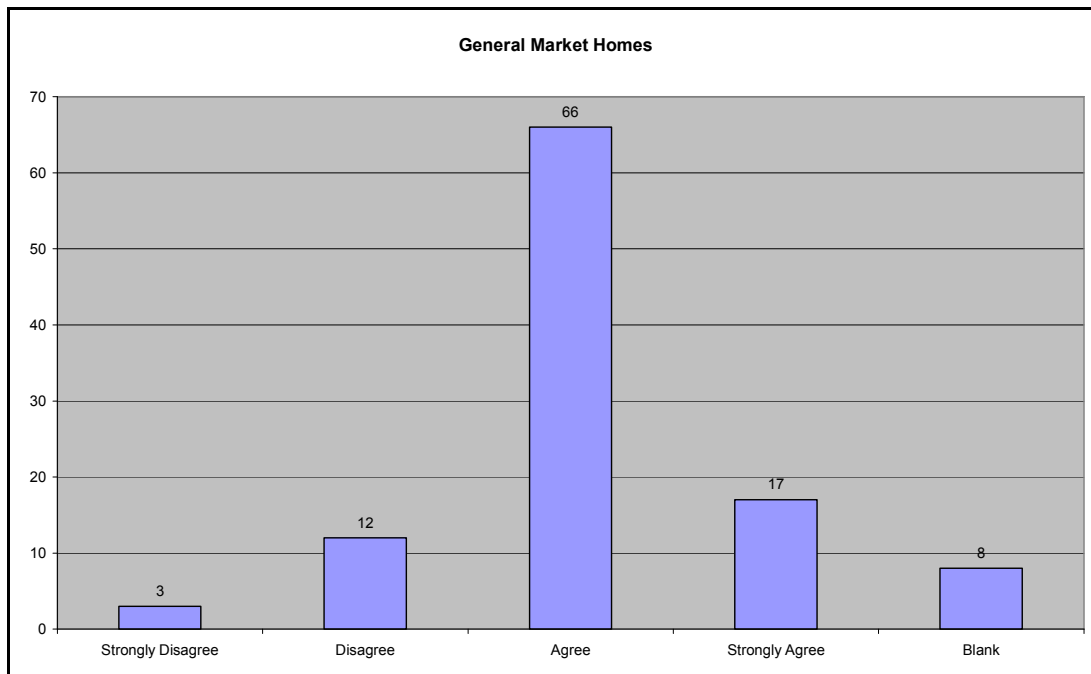
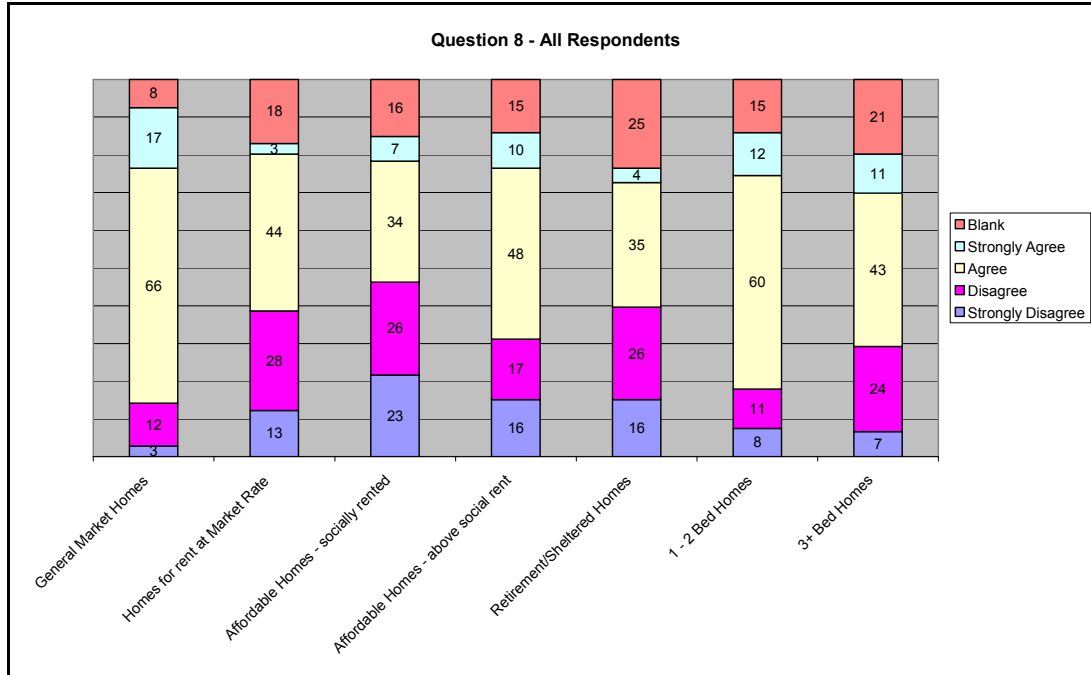
Most people (almost 50%) thought that 1 - 50 was an appropriate number of new home so build in the next 15 years.

Only 8% thought that more than 100 homes should e built in Brereton parish in the next 15 years.

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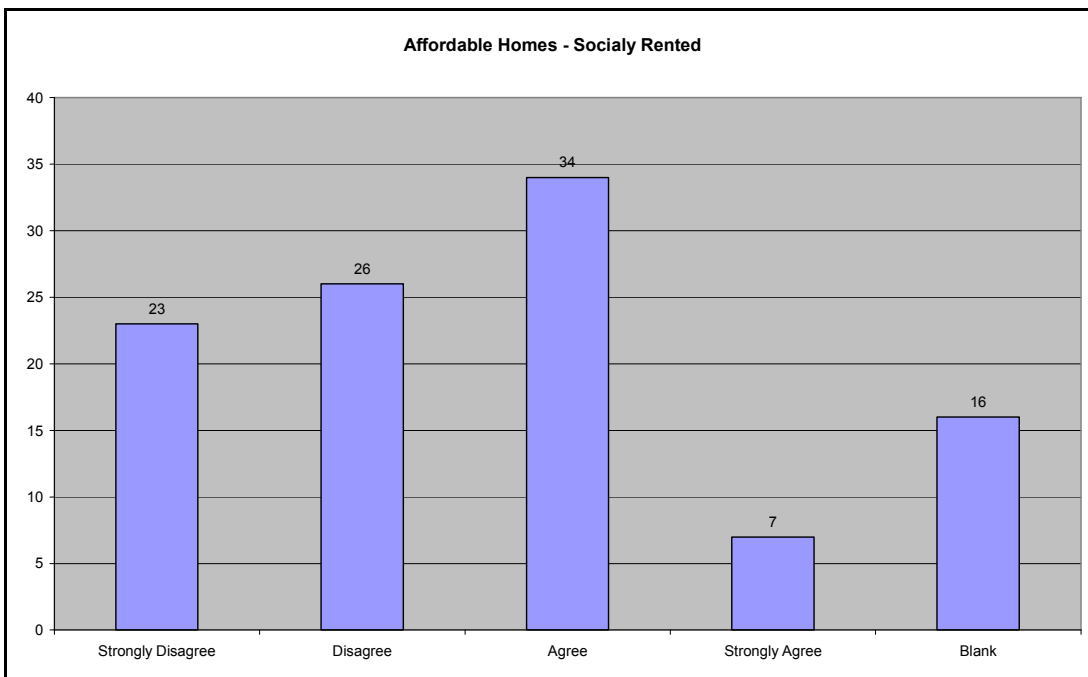
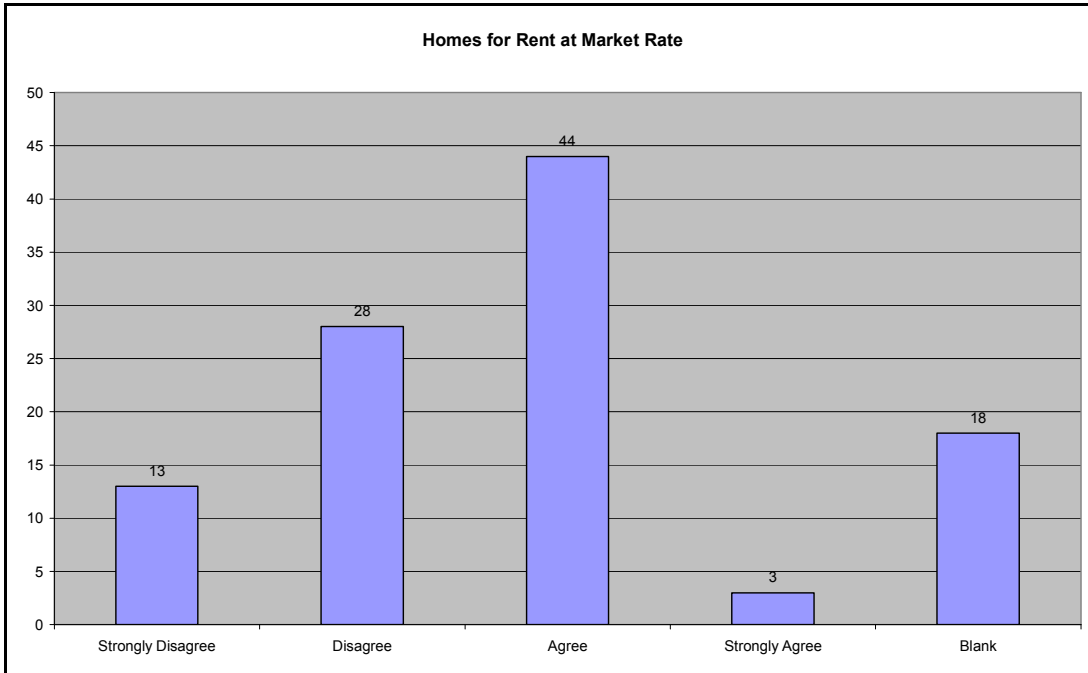
Question 8: If new homes have to be built in Brereton Parish, should these be of a particular type?

This chart compares the responses for the different types of home. More detailed charts follow this one.



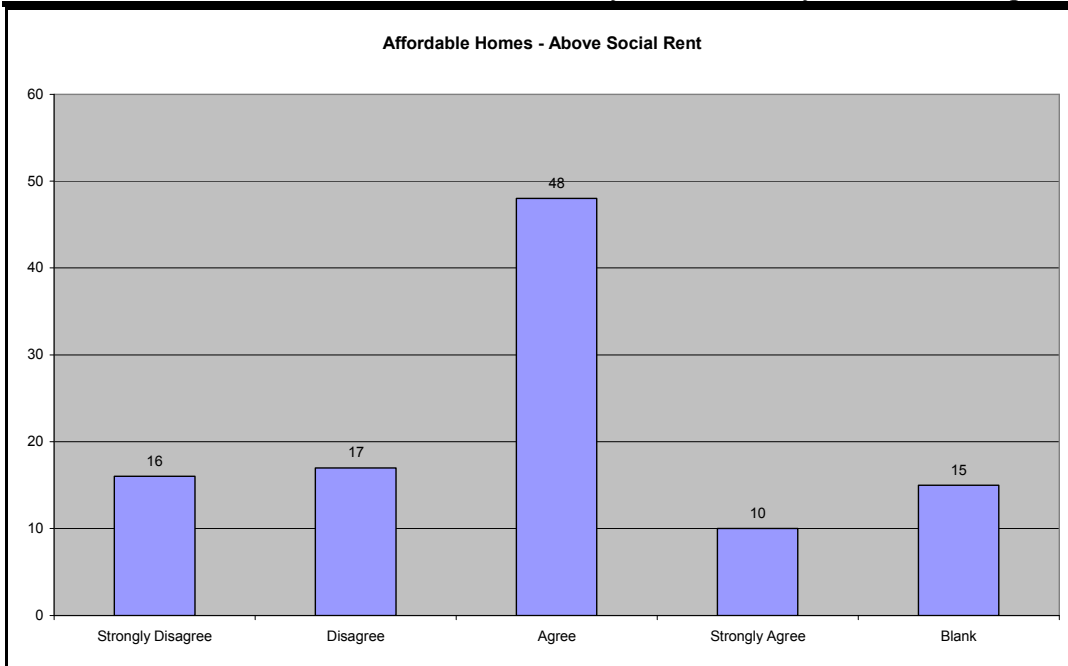
A lot more people agree than disagree that if new homes have to be built in Brereton Parish, they should be general market homes.

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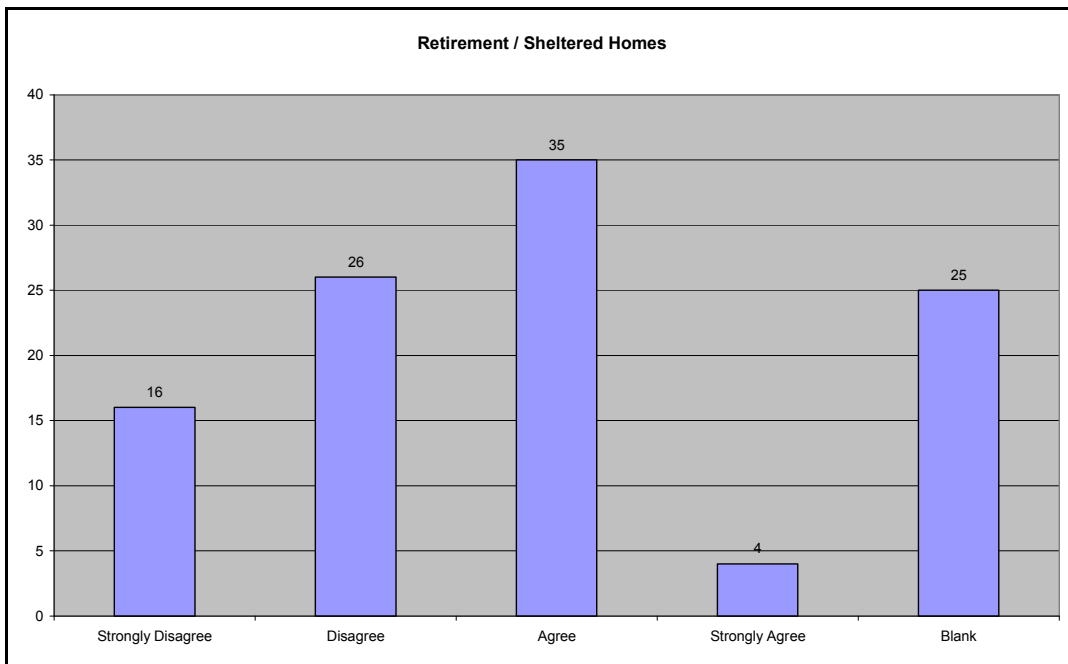


In total, more people disagree than agree that if new homes have to be built in Brereton Parish, they should be affordable homes to rent at prices of social rent.

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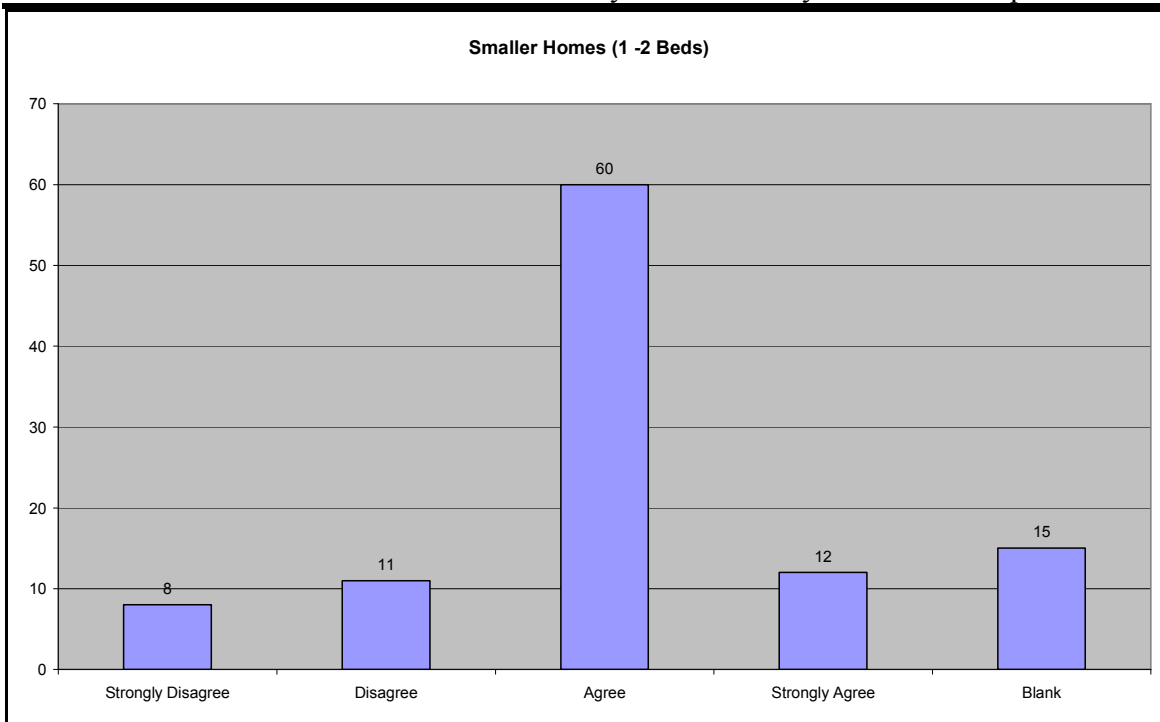


In total, more people agree than disagree that if new homes have to be built in Brereton Parish, they should be affordable homes above prices of those of social rent

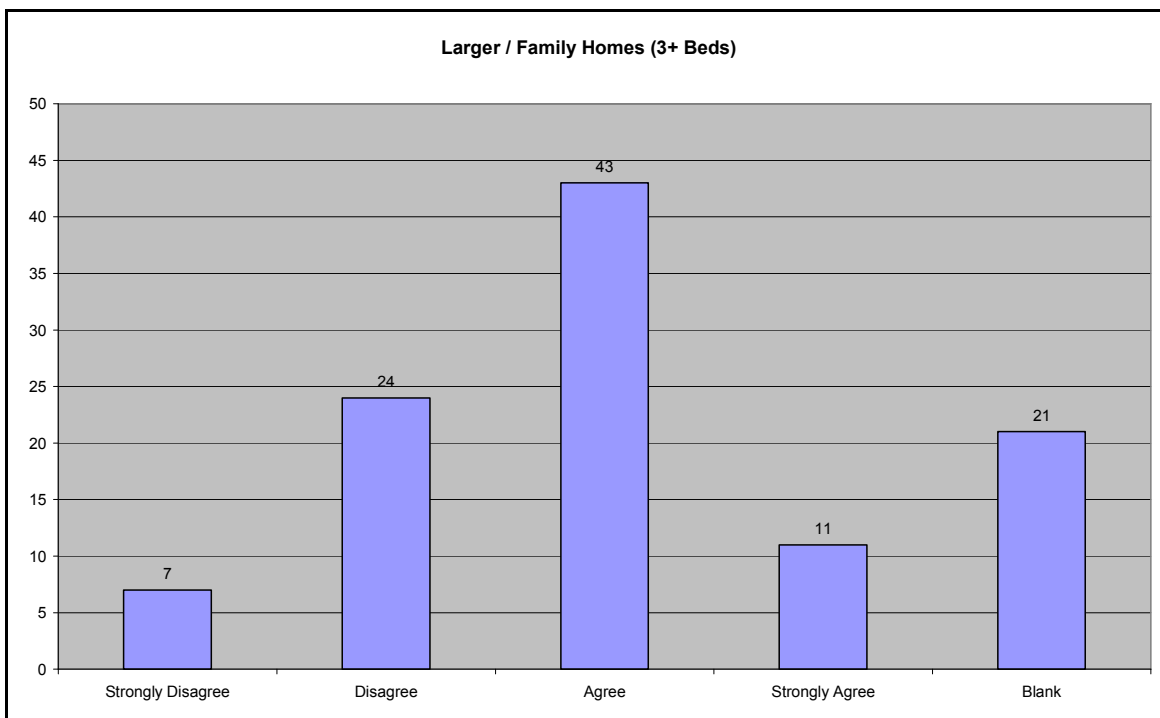


In total, slightly more people disagree than agree that if new homes have to be built in Brereton Parish, they should be retirement/sheltered homes.

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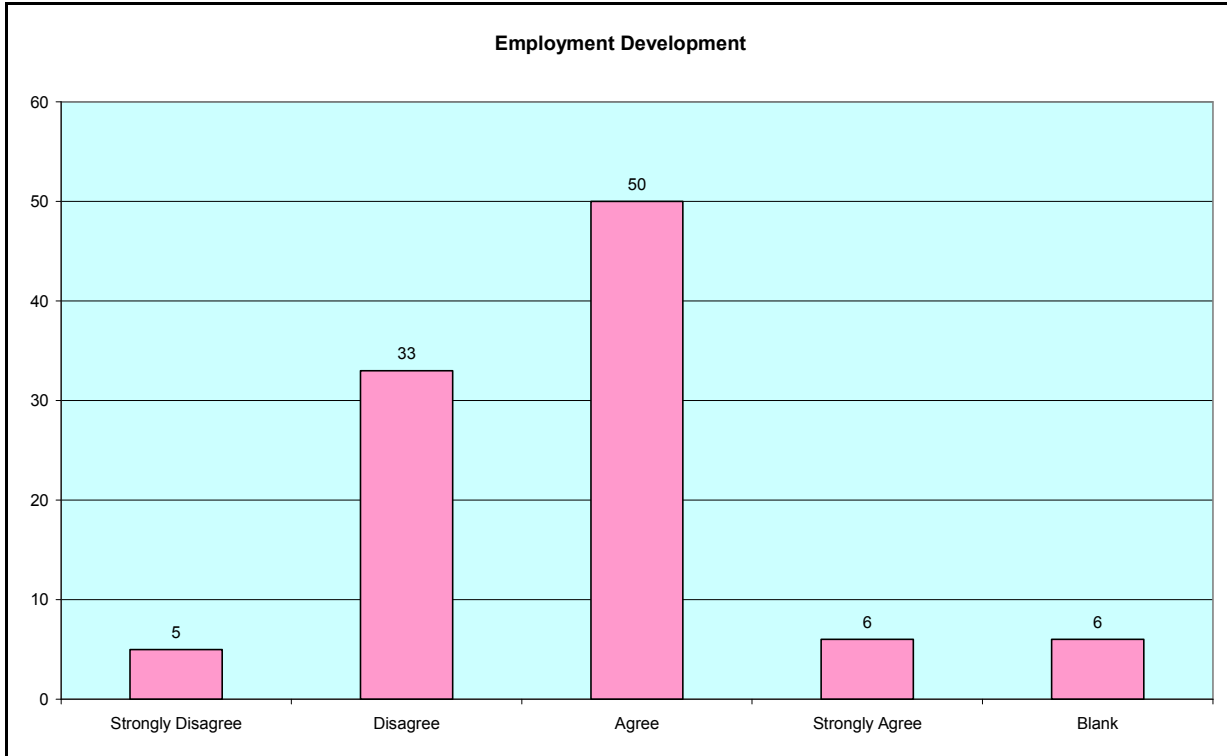


A lot more people agree than disagree that if new homes have to be built in Brereton Parish, they should be smaller homes.



A lot more people agree than disagree that if new homes have to be built in Brereton Parish, they should be smaller homes.

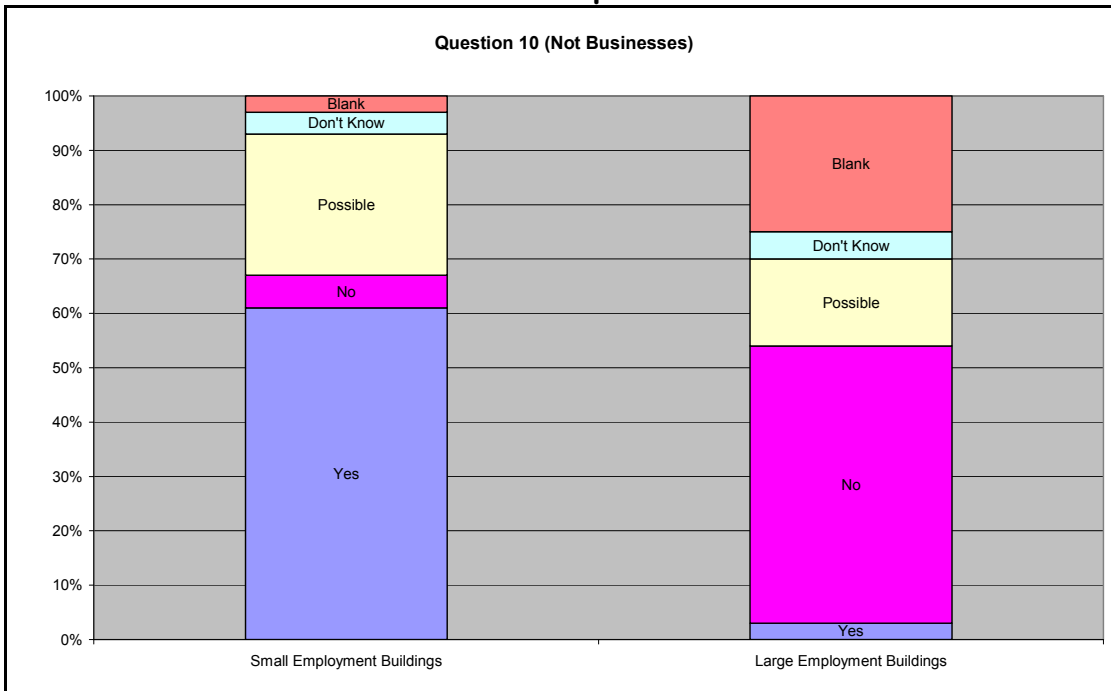
Question 9: Over the next 15 years, do you think that there will be a need for more places of employment located in Brereton Parish?



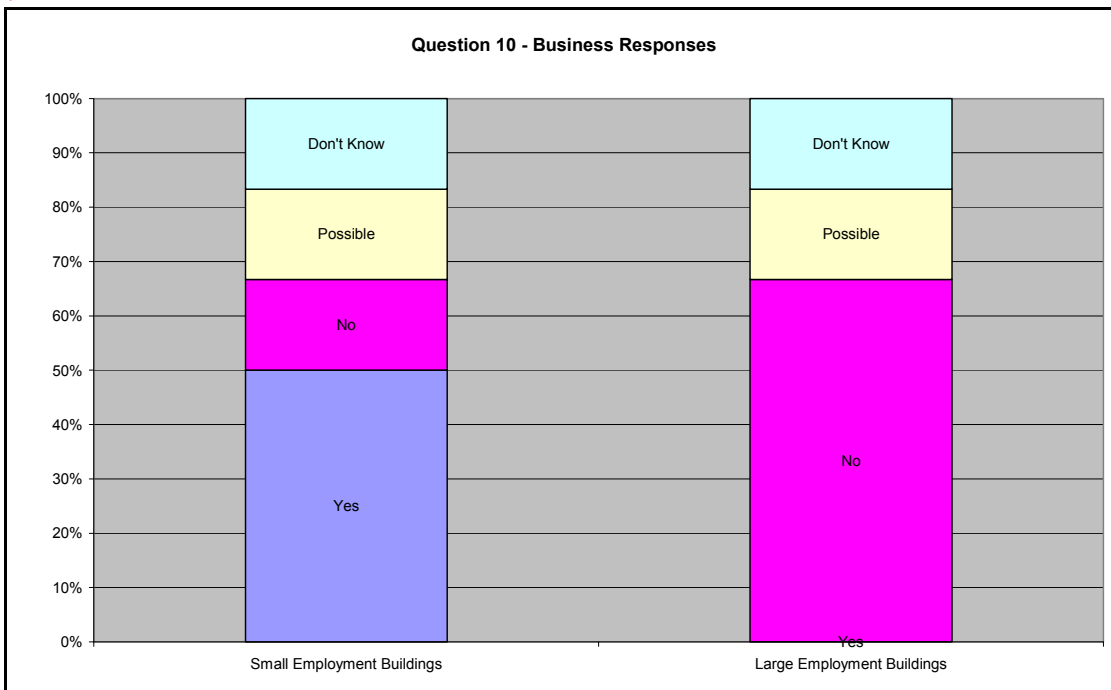
56% of respondents thought that over the next 15 years, there will be a need for more places of employment to be located in Brereton Parish?

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Question 10: If there is to be new employment development, what type do you think would suit Brereton parish?



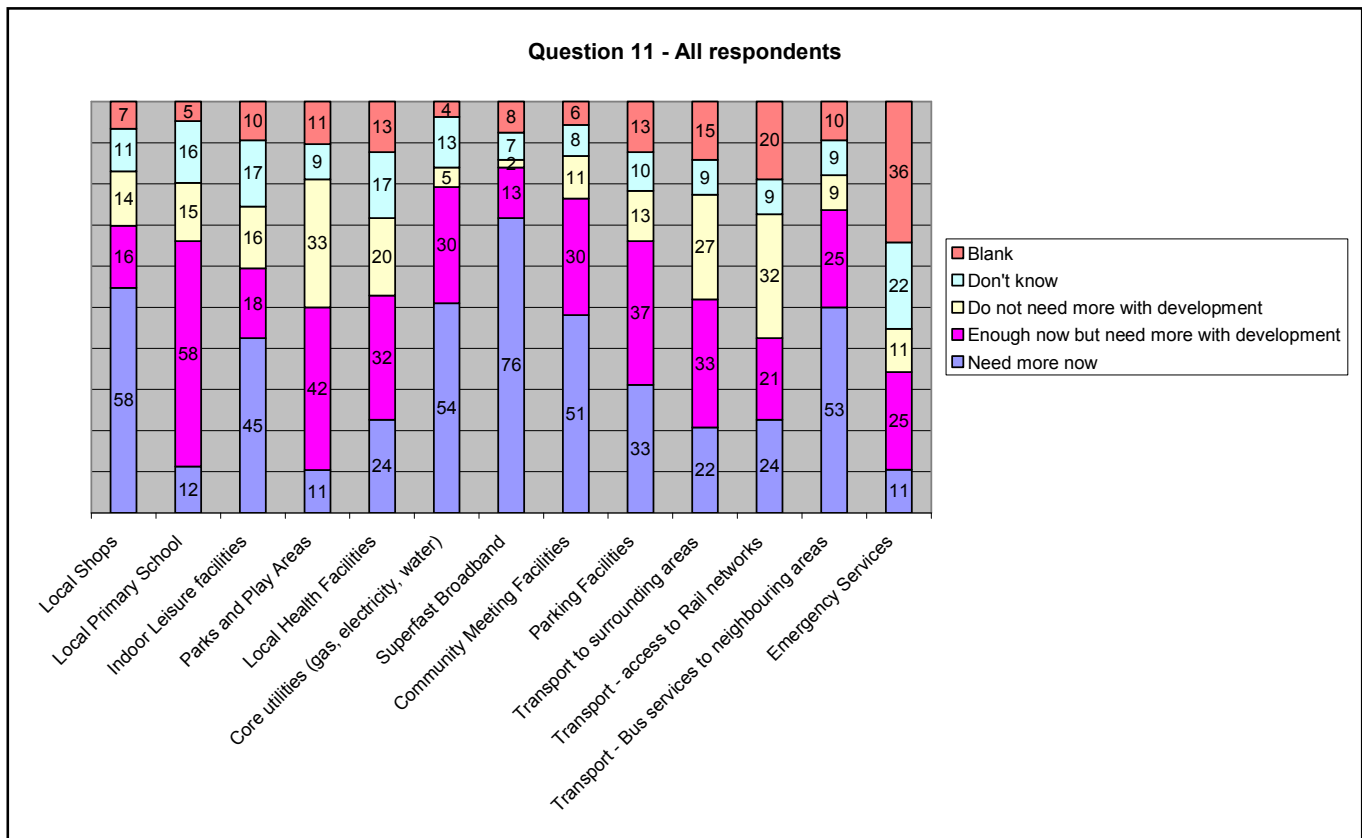
The majority of respondents would favour small employment buildings in Brereton Parish in the future



The business responses also favoured small employment buildings in Brereton Parish in the future.

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Question 11: Please indicate which of the following you think might apply in Brereton parish.



Superfast Broadband was the facility that was considered to be most needed now.

The local Primary School, parks and play areas and emergency services were that 3 facilities that most people considered to be adequate at the moment.

The local Primary School was the facility (more than any of the others) that was considered to need to expand if there was more development.

There were several facilities where the majority of people felt that either we needed more now or we would need more with new development in Brereton Parish: local shops; indoor leisure facilities; core utilities (several specific references to gas); community meeting facilities; parking facilities; bus transport.
