



Vision and Objectives

Summary

The Vision is an aspirational statement, providing a foundation for all other content of the Neighbourhood Plan. It declares a view of and direction for the area, to guide the Plan's development.

The Objectives are specific targets to be achieved during the course of the 15-year Plan.

Vision

In 15 years Brereton will be a vibrant, predominantly rural community encouraging prosperity for residents and local businesses alike. Local agriculture will remain a valued feature of local life.

It will support high quality development to meet local needs in keeping with the character of the area.

Its will provide outdoor recreation and open space to benefit people in our own and neighbouring areas. It will be a Green Gap, separating and balancing the continuing development of surrounding towns and villages.

It will be a place where local people can live, work, play, and enjoy a high quality of life.


Objectives

Question: Do you agree or not with the draft Vision & Objectives?



All respondents agreed.

Specific comments and opinions were raised for each Objective:

- O1: A village hall would be ideal in the vision, but built on land already developed
- O1: This will depend upon the size of development
- O2: Housing should only be considered in connection with increase in population. Empty housing should be used
- O2: Need affordable housing, but should be in keeping with rural character not big estates.
- O2: Would need to see the plan
- O3: They are quite good already but the gates on the bridal paths need sorting as impossible to ride through.
- O3: This is important as the lanes are narrow & need to be protected.
- O3: Yes
- O4: Brereton is a place to live not to develop industry
- O4: Not very many jobs for locals. Should support local businesses.
- O4: This is important and could be part of the area near the pub; post office and shop.
- O5: Needed but improved transport will not be cost effective
- O5: This is essential for home working. We need superfast broadband.
- O5: Traffic too fast on quiet lanes. Internet facilities. Broadband etc need improving.
- O6: The work done is already very good.
- O6: We must protect the green space.
